## **Over-the-counter Medications that are Safe During Pregnancy**

In general, it is best to try to avoid medications in the first three months of pregnancy. Listed below are some over-the-counter medications that are approved for use during pregnancy. It is important for you to discuss <u>all</u> medications you are taking with your physician.   - o Tylenol (acetaminophen) products for minor aches and pains
  - o DO NOT TAKE Aspirin, Ibuprofen, Motrin, Advil, Naprosyn, Aleve
- Colds/Allergies/Coughs
  - Benadryl (do not drive while using, may cause drowsiness)
  - Dimetapp
  - o Claritin
  - Chlortrimeton
  - Drixoral
  - Benylin
  - Saline Nasal Spray
  - Sudafed (pseudoephedrine) 14 weeks or later in pregnancy
  - Robitussin DM Cough Syrup
  - Actifed
  - Tylenol products

  - Singulair
  - Vicks Vapor Rub
  - Zyrtec
  - Flonase
- Sore Throat
  - Chloroseptic Spray of Lozenges
  - Tylenol
  - o Lemon Drops, Cepacol, Halls or Robitussin Lozenges
- Heartburn/Indigestion
  - Maalox
  - Mylanta
  - Digel
  - o Gas X
  - o Pepcid AC
  - o Riopan
  - Rolaids
  - o Tums

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- Nausea/Morning Sickness
  - Vitamin B6 50mg, 1 tablet 4 times a day
  - o Dramamine as directed

  - o DO NOT TAKE Pepto Bismol (contains aspirin)
- Gas/Bloating

  - o Anusol-HC suppositories or cream
  - o Preparation H
  - o Tucks Pads
- Sleep Aid
  - o Tylenol PM
  - o Unisom
- Toothaches
  - o Orajel

- Yeast Infections
  - o Monistat
